HEALTH AND EDUCATION

Just a short walk from our main campus, the Brooks building hosts specialist facilities designed for health and education. Included in this space is the 'Cave' - our immersive learning environment, clinical simulation suites and purpose-built teaching classrooms. Around the impressive 'Spanish Steps' you can find places to grab something to eat or drink, lecture theatres and our Student Hub, where you can access a range of support.

BUSINESS AND LAW

Most teaching for business related subjects takes place in our Business School. With its modern glass exterior and large open plan atria, it's always a hive of activity. For law subjects, most teaching takes place in the Sandra Burslem building, where you can also find our mock courtroom which is the ideal place to test advocacy and mooting skills. Within the Business School all our students have easy access to the Student Hub and our Careers Hub, where you can get support with work placements and graduate careers.

SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING

We've recently invested heavily to enhance the facilities in the John Dalton building – and we continue to do so. Over the next two years, we'll be updating our existing spaces to create an outstanding teaching and research environment with dedicated computing suites, heavy engineering workshops and seven floors of state-of-the-art laboratories.

Opening in 2023, our new science and engineering building will provide new and improved collaborative teaching spaces, including a 200-student capacity 'super lab'.

INSTITUTE OF SPORT

HUMANITIES, LANGUAGES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES

Our students will benefit from the facilities and support offered across the Geoffrey Manton and Grosvenor buildings. Home to the Manchester Poetry Library, the prestigious Manchester Writing School and the Language Centre, students will be joining a community of creative thinkers. And, with access to purpose-built seminar rooms, a wide range of lecture theatres, and specialist facilities including state-of-the-art TV and radio studios, our students have the tools they need to excel.

SCHOOL OF DIGITAL ARTS (SODA)

Students will join our exciting creative community in the new SODA building. Equipped with the latest technology, students will have access to an extensive range of specialist facilities to develop their industry-ready skills for creating and researching content across the latest digital platforms. These include a digital innovation and UX lab, film studios, green screens, edit suites, sound, music and production studios, a screening room and a gallery.

MANCHESTER FASHION INSTITUTE

The home of Manchester Fashion Institute is the Grade II listed Righton building, with its industry standard technical facilities housed in the adjacent Cavendish building. The department also makes use of facilities across the All Saints campus with design courses utilising specialist equipment in the Benzie building and larger lectures also taking place in the Business School and the Geoffrey Manton building.

MANCHESTER SCHOOL OF ART

Home to an extensive range of digital and technical workshops, including ceramics, glass, bookbinding, jewellery and more, the interconnected art and design complex for School of Art students includes the RIBA award-winning Benzie building, Chatham Tower and the historic Grosvenor building, first opened in 1881. Students will also benefit from purpose-built lecture theatres and study spaces in the adjacent Geoffrey Manton Building.
